In Southern California, nonprofit organizations play a vital role in addressing the diverse needs of one of the nation's largest and most dynamic populations. From providing food and shelter to expanding access to education, healthcare, and the arts, these organizations work tirelessly to uplift individuals and strengthen neighborhoods across the region. Among them, the Get Together Foundation has distinguished itself through its hands-on approach to community service, partnering with local organizations and volunteers to deliver meaningful assistance where it is needed most. By combining charitable outreach with the unifying power of music and community engagement, the Foundation has become an inspiring example of how local nonprofits can create lasting change.

The Get Together Foundation was created with a simple but powerful mission: to bring people together to make the world a better place to live and love. Co-founded by Kevin and Mare Wachs, the nonprofit was built on the belief that charitable giving should have a direct and meaningful impact. By keeping overhead low and relying on volunteers, the organization has remained committed to ensuring that donations are put into action quickly and used where they are needed most—helping children, families, and communities facing hardship.

The organization began partnering with other local nonprofits, faith-based organizations, businesses, and service providers to deliver assistance where it was needed most. By focusing on partnerships and direct community involvement, the Foundation continues to help create opportunities and hope for those facing difficult circumstances throughout Southern California.

One of the Foundation's defining characteristics is its belief in the power of music to inspire hope and create opportunity. In 2022, GTF launched its music enrichment program, Together in Tune, which offers underserved youth access to music education, instrument instruction, creative expression, and mentorship in a fun and supportive environment.

Led by qualified music teachers, the program is currently offered in facilities such as Boys & Girls Clubs, YMCAs, and various afterschool programs. Together in Tune gives

kids from 7 to 17 years of age the opportunity to participate in fun and exciting music classes throughout Greater Los Angeles and continues to grow the program throughout Southern California.

In addition to its educational programs, the organization regularly hosts benefit concerts and community events that bring artists, volunteers, donors, and local residents together to raise funds and awareness for important causes. These events not only generate critical support for the Foundation's programs but also reinforces its belief that music has the unique ability to unite people from all walks of life.

On July 3, the Get Together Foundation will be hosting its annual charity event at The Canyon, Agoura Hills. This event will be a very special orchestrated tribute to The Beatles – complete with an incredible string section and an array of stellar singers – joining the Tribe band. The Tribe's unique take on some of the most beloved songs of all time includes unique performances

not to miss. You'll get to enjoy some of your favorite Tribe singers performing some of your favorite songs, including some danceables to finish out the evening.

Over more than two decades, the Get Together Foundation has evolved into an organization that embodies its rallying cry, "WE C.A.N. (Citizen Activism Now)." Whether providing emergency relief during times of crisis, helping families transition into permanent housing, or creating opportunities for children to learn music, the Foundation continues to demonstrate how collective action and community involvement can create lasting change. Its work serves as a reminder that when people come together with a shared purpose, even small acts of kindness can have a profound impact.

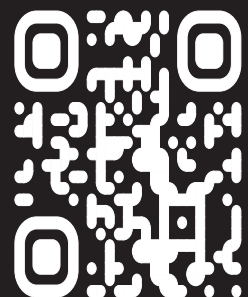
